Our focus verse from Isaiah 64 helps us see that God shapes us in useful and beautiful ways. One way God shaped many of the giants of faith from the past is in humility. The Bible mentions that Moses, even though he was God's chosen leader for the Israelites, was a very humble man (Numbers 12:3). In the New Testament, the Apostle Paul, though one of the brightest leaders in the early Christian Church, called himself a "servant/slave" (Titus 1:1).

We can be proud of accomplishments, abilities, and blessings, but the key is to give the glory and thanks to God for what He has done as the potter of our lives. The more we accomplish, the more we say with Paul, "Let him who boasts, boast of the Lord." (1 Cor. 1:31)
