## Directions

This summer you will read as much as you can for fun. Choose middle school level books or higher and read often. As you read, create a scrapbook to document your reading. This scrapbook must provide evidence to prove you did the items you checked. (You may create a digital scrapbook if you prefer.) Here is a list of some, but not all, of the options for ways to provide proof of your reading activities.

- Parent signature,
- Dated journal entry,
- Ticket stub,
- Selfies reading on the beach (or under a tree, or somewhere special),
- Book summary,
- Showtell item that relates,

- Brief form with the following: In what time period was the book set? What was the theme? Why did it interest you? Etc.

Essentially, the scrapbook is created to prove that you did each of the items you claim to have done. Your grade will be calculated based on the point value for each item you do. You should accumulate a total of 100 points.
