HEALTHY TOGETHER

RLS is still on schedule to open its doors physically to students on Wednesday, August 19, 2020 under the "Yellow" scenario as outlined in the [Healthy Together Plan](#). Please carefully review Mr. Kolb's latest email correspondence dated Friday, July 31, 2020 addressing important modifications and updates to the Healthy Together Plan.

A critical component to our success will revolve around frequent hand washing and proper use of face coverings. **Please remember that face coverings are MANDATORY for RLS students and staff.** Face coverings will be required by all in the public places of our building or where social distancing can not be maintained (carpool, small group activities). We understand that wearing a face covering is easier for older students. Based on Governor Cooper's recent statements along with the City of Raleigh face covering order (applying to all 12 and older), **RLS has determined that Middle School students MUST wear face coverings when they are inside the building in their bubbles.** Breaks will be worked into the schedule when students are socially distant and/or outside for recess or engaged in outdoor education. We continue to STRONGLY ENCOURAGE ALL to wear face coverings at ALL TIMES. Please know that the face covering policy, as well as all our Healthy Together policies and procedures, are subject to change based on the guidelines put forth by our state and local authorities and recommendations of national health organizations.



One last encouragement...we would ask that as the first days of school approach please consider limiting travel and exposure to risk as much as possible so that we can all get a healthy start to the school year. Thank you in advance for your consideration.
